

- The school Will also oblide by the conditions prescribed. If any, by the State Government opnoemed as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (OED) Inquivalent officer,
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff adevalopment and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://dbse.nic.in/ for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire tighting and Transportation. etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for polable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic tollets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- Admission to the echool is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5. 11 72 2 4 2 4 3 40 8 other relevant name of Affiliation has been

- 9. The number of sections in the school are restricted to 36 as per number of sections reported by the IC and shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of affiliation bye laws.
- 10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
- The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc.
- The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in.
- 13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bys Laws of the Board.
- 14. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/upgradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 16. The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
- Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/ notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any faxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per Chapter 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
- 18. Conditions, if any, to be submitted within 60 days.

- * The school is required to submit the details of the area of the campus of previous affiliation/upgradation/subsequent extension. If there is any variation in area of the campus, then school is required to submit its clarification in the matter. The school is required to comply the previous grant conditions if any, imposed by the Board on school at the time of precious grant of affiliation. The grant of extension is subject to the condition that there is no change in land of the school and no show cause/complaint/legal issues pending against the school and subject to fulfillment of previous conditions mentioned in affiliation/upgradation/ subsequent extension granted earlier.
- *The school has submitted the recognition certificate from class VI to VIII. The school is required to submit Recognition Certificate from class I to Class VIII from State Education Board as per the Section 18 of Right to Education Act, 2009.
